The best and most complete sample of what this seal of quality means will be on display in the large space reserved within the Salón Gourmets.

Tierra de Sabor is already a well-known indicator that guarantees the quality and traceability of healthy products rooted in the territory, as will be shown in the different activities, talks and tastings held at its stand. These include sausages, meats, cheeses, truffles and, of course, wine.

With the co-sponsorship of Bodegas Protos and Nespresso, Tierra de Sabor also sponsors the traditional and renowned Sommeliers Spanish Championship, now returning for its 26th year. The contest aims increase the visibility of sommelier culture as well as selecting the top professional who will represent Spain in the World Sommeliers' Championship. The jury comprises the presidents of Sommeliers' Associations from different provinces and representatives from the event sponsors. As a new addition this year, Damián Seijas, professional barista and Nespresso ambassador, will offer a masterclass, including a tasting of 4 varieties of Nespresso Professional.
