The Ministry of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food (MAPA) returns to **Salon Gourmets** with the **#Alimentosdespaña Area**, where visitors can discover some of the most unique Spanish products covered by their respective quality seals. From **April 22 to 25**, show cookings, lectures and presentations will take place on the stage to showcase the versatility of quality food and beverages under the campaign slogan: "**The Tastiest Country in the World**".

The Official Inauguration of the most exclusive Fine Food and Beverages Fair in Europe will take place **on 22 April at 11:00 am** with the presence of María Begoña García Bernal, Secretary of State for Agriculture and Food of the MAPA, who will be received by Francisco López Canís and Francisco López Bago, honorary president and president of the Gourmets Group respectively, to accompany her and the retinue of regional authorities and members of the diplomatic corps from various countries, on their tour through halls 8, 5, 3, 4 and 6 at Ifema Madrid.

The activities planned on the MAPA / The Tastiest Country in the World stage will begin with FEDEPESCA explaining the differences between the Japanese clam, fine clam and slug; OPROMAR will show how to make the most of fish in each recipe; INTERFISH-SPAIN will show the main characteristics of blue shark, swordfish and mako shark; ANACEF will prepare different fish dishes ideal for batch cooking, while Pesca España will harmonize fish and seafood with cocktails.

The extra virgin olive oils will also have great prominence, especially during the breakfasts that will be prepared every morning at stand with coffee, bread and different award-winning oils. But also in the 6th EVOO Tunnel / MAPA visitors will be able to taste more than 100 varieties, some unique, others of organic production and, of course, the winners of the "Food of Spain" Awards.

The wines will be present in the 28th Wine Tunnel / MAPA, one of the most visited areas of the Salón Gourmets. 22 grape varieties and 340 single-variety wines of 274 wineries, selected by the technicians of the Ministry of Agriculture together with the Tasting Committee of the Wine
