The quality and flavour of Galician products will be present at the 38th edition of Salon Gourmets (SG) -from 7 to 10 April 2025 in Ifema Madrid- with an exclusive stage where the uniqueness of both seafood and rural products will be displayed during a whole day. Galicia Day features show cookings and presentations that will bring to the public the most select products under the Protected Designation of Origin (PDO) and Protected Geographical Indication (PGI) quality seals.

Products such as **Mel de Galicia (honey)**, cheeses such as those from the **Queixo Tetilla PDO**, winners in the semisoft cow's milk category in the latest edition of the best Spanish Cheeses Championship 2024, to which nearly 900 samples were submitted, and not forgetting **its sustainable livestock** and an impressive variety of **other products from its fields**. The **richness of its coasts** will also be present, with the pescadeRías seal of identity, which guarantees the defence of fish and seafood from the Galician artisanal fleet. Its **wines with designation of origin will be presented** at the tastings that form part of the programme of activities which takes place throughout the day in this exclusive setting.

For four days, Europe's most exclusive International Fine Food and Beverages Fair, **turns Madrid into the capital of gourmet products par excellence**, not only because of the number of products exhibited year after year, more than 50,000 in its last edition, but also because of the parallel activities organised with more than 8,000 m2 or, in other words, 9 stages, designed to bring gourmet products closer to professional visitors. This year, for the first time, it will also occupy **six halls**, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7 and 8, where more than 115,000 professional visitors are expected to attend, 16,000 of them foreign buyers from more than 90 countries.
