**Madrid, february 2025.-** The wine sector is one of Spain's economic, social and cultural pillars; it is the key to our identity as a country and a major attraction for visitors and tourists. It represents a sector committed to sustainability and, furthermore, it drives development in numerous towns and small cities, contributing to territorial cohesion and generating quality employment. The leading wine companies of the moment and their most powerful references will be present at the Europe's most exclusive Fine Food and Beverages Fair, Salon Gourmets (SG). With Estrella Galicia as the official beer, the next edition will bring the



latest news from the world food and beverage sector and, of course, from the world of wine. From 7 to 10 April at Ifema Madrid, visitors will discover more than 55,000 products from all over the world, many of them wines. In total, close to 2,100 exhibitors will fill the six halls - 3, 4, 5, 6, 7 and 8 - that the 38th edition of SG will occupy.

Spain occupies a very prominent position in the world of wine at national and international level: it is the largest vineyard on the planet, with 913,695 hectares in 2023, and the third largest producer in the world. Moreover, the wine sector accounts for 1.9% of Spain's GDP. It is also a market that generates and maintains 363,980 jobs - 2% of the total in Spain. In terms of tourism, it also leaves its mark: almost three million people a year visit the wineries and museums of the Wine Routes of Spain; we have 97 protected designations of origin, including designations of origin, qualified designations of origin, quality wines and quality wines.

In addition to the exhibitors, the 38th edition of Salon Gourmets will feature multiple spaces and activities - over the four days of the fair there will be more than 1,200 - with which to learn more about this sector, taste the most outstanding references or discover who is the best sommelier in Spain. The Ministry of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food (MAPA) will bring visitors closer to the quality of Spanish produce in its #Alimentosdespaña space. The traditional Wine Tunnel / MAPA will be here, a unique place to explore the quality of the 57 wine regions represented through 358 wines, 277 wineries and 22 varieties at the 29th edition.

Another unmissable stop for those who want to keep abreast of the most outstanding wines and wineries is The Best of the Gourmets Wine Guide (LMG) space, where those references that have obtained a rating equal to or higher than 90 points and which, therefore, form part of the Gourmets Wine Guide (GVG) 2025 Honour Roll, which this year celebrates its 40th anniversary, are exhibited. The GVG is a benchmark in the Spanish wine sector, maintaining its rigour and impartiality thanks to its blind tasting system, since its first edition in 1983. Once again this year, it shows the varied offer and typology of the most interesting Spanish wines; it includes 1,270 wineries and 4,914 wines reviewed, with exclusive discounts for readers in 159 wineries and specialised shops, consolidating itself as a key source of information for professionals in the sector, wine tourists and wine lovers.
